We believe that all children are capable of learning, yet we understand that children may need various levels of support in order to be successful in the classroom. The SOAAR Program at NCA seeks to provide individualized support for children with disabilities, while including all children within the general education classroom to the fullest extent possible. Individual Education Programs (IEPs) will shape the educational goals for your child, and will outline which supports are needed in order for your child to reach his or her goals each academic school year. We invite you to explore what SOAAR has to offer your child, and complete the following application to enroll your child in the SOAAR program at NCA.

Enrollment Procedure / Proceso de Inscripción

- 1. Complete the New Student Application and all required attachments for the standard admissions process.
- 2. Complete SOAAR Application (attached) and return to NCA office.
- 3. Provide copy of most recent IEP (Individual Education Plan)/Psychological Report* (if applicable).
- 4. Provide copy of reports from Occupational, Physical, and Speech Therapists (if applicable).
- 5. Provide copy of any additional, relevant testing (educational, neurological, hearing, vision, etc.).
- 6. Following completion of steps 1-5, SOAAR staff will schedule an admissions exploratory meeting with student and family to discuss program details and eligibility.

*Required for children entering 2nd grade and higher

What is the SOAAR Program?

The SOAAR program provides individualized support for learners with disabilities, supporting students within the general education classroom as much as possible, while allowing for special education support as deemed necessary. Each student's needed supports may be outlined in an individualized education program (IEP), developed by school staff and families through an annual collaborative process.

The SOAAR program offers "tiers" of support to individual learners based on students' gifts and needs.

Tier Level	Possible supports include:		
Tier 1: Consultation provided by Learning Resources or SOAAR teacher	Classroom modifications in general education classroom (i.e. specialized seating and equipment, organizational support, learning strategies, testing accommodations, behavioral support) provided through consultation with SOAAR department; participation in after-school tutoring program.		
Tier 2: Direct support provided by Learning Resources or SOAAR teacher	See Tier 1 supports. Additionally, Learning Resources teacher provides between 30-60 minutes daily of direct support for strengthening academic skills and/or SOAAR teacher provides direct social skills/behavioral support.		
Tier 3: Significant support provided by SOAAR classroom teacher	Some of instruction in core academics (i.e. reading, math) from the SOAAR classroom teacher in special education classroom; majority of instruction with general education peers whenever possible.		
	Part-time SOAAR assistants possibly required for inclusion with assistant: student ratio of 1:1-1:2; potential participation in " <i>Circle of Friends</i> " programming to increase positive peer relationships.		
	Applicable related services such as speech, occupational, and physical therapy provided through consultation in cooperation with outside organizations; implemented by NCA staff.		
	Possible modified curriculum, grading, and behavior system as needed; students may need to finish NCA with a certificate of completion.		
Tier 4: Maximum support provided by SOAAR classroom teacher	See Tier 3 Support, except increased modified instruction from the SOAAR classroom teacher in special education classroom as needed; instruction with general education peers whenever possible.		
	SOAAR assistants required for inclusion for behavioral support or to meet physical needs: student assistant ratio of 1:1		
Non-eligible students for SOAAR program	Students with behaviors that create potentially dangerous situations to themselves or others within the NCA community.		
	Students with learning difficulties <i>primarily</i> as a result of English language learning		
	SOAAR team makes all final decisions regarding admission to the program.		

2025-2026 SOAAR Fees

All fees in Nicaraguan córdobas (or equivalent in USD).

Tier 1 and 2: No additional fees required. Students pay standard tuition rates. Classroom accommodations and limited resource room services provided by SOAAR or Learning Resources teacher up to 60 minutes per school day. Tier 3 Preschool/Kindergarten.....C\$ 69,587 (USD 1,900) annual fee Elementary/Secondary.....C\$ 95,223 (USD 2,600) annual fee This monthly additional fee covers the expense of a classroom assistant (shadow teacher) to support your child in the general education classroom (1:1-2 ratio), as well as specialized instruction and materials provided by the SOAAR program. Tier 4 Preschool/Kindergarten.....C\$ 139,172 (USD 3,800) annual fee Elementary/Secondary.....C\$ 190,446 (USD 5,200) annual fee This monthly additional fee covers the expense of a classroom assistant (shadow teacher) to support your child in the general education classroom (1:1 ratio), as well as specialized instruction and materials provided by the SOAAR program. Additional Possible Fees: After-school tutoring with NCA staff members or high school students, supervised by Learning Resources teacher. Speech and Language Programming...... C\$ 275 (USD 7.50) per 30-minute session On-site therapist provides direct support for students in need of speech and language services (as possible). Therapy Consultation and Programming......TBD

Students requiring physical and occupational therapies may be asked to pay additional fees for consultation or direct services provided by outside organizations (i.e. Tesoros de Dios, Worldwide Speech)

In cases where the specific needs of a student require a higher degree of specialization than what our school normally offers, it may be necessary to hire additional services, staff or professional services to meet the specific needs of a student. In these cases, the family would be responsible for the additional costs incurred.

- In addition to the rates above, the student must pay all other required fees (one-time enrollment fee, annual registration fee, technology fee, etc.).
