FACULTY

All of NCA's 36 teachers and administrators profess a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and have an average of 14.7 years of educational experience. We enjoy a diverse community of teachers and staff from North America, Nicaragua, and several other countries, united by our love for God and desire to serve Him through Christian education!

STUDENTS

The school has a current enrollment of 330 students in grades Pre-K through 12. Fifty-three percent are Nicaraguan, 30 percent are North American, 10 percent are South Korean, and the rest represent 9 other countries in Central America and around the world. Class sizes are limited to 18-25 students, providing individual attention for each student. Ninety-five percent of our graduates go on to college; about 70% in the U.S.

NCA is an evangelical, non-denominational, non-profit K-12 school. Founded in 1991, NCA has dual U.S. accreditation with the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS). It is our mission to equip children of Christian parents with the spiritual discernment, the moral courage, and the academic excellence to impact society through Christian living motivated by a heartfelt love for God.

MISSION: Educate Missionary Kids.

Thirty-one percent of our students are MK's (Missionary Kids). It is our desire that they will gain a cultural understanding of their host country and a passion for mission work, in Nicaragua and around the world. Without the educational opportunities offered by NCA, it would be difficult or impossible for many of the missionaries to carry out the full-time ministries to which God has called them in Nicaragua.

MISSION: Train Up Future Leaders.

Nicaragua is in desperate need of moral leadership. For hundreds of years, Nicaragua's leaders have made decisions out of a desire for personal gain and have lacked moral integrity, commitment to social justice, and compassion toward their people, resulting in widespread poverty and corruption. Fifty-three percent of NCA students are Nicaraguan and will be future leaders in their country. Our vision is to give

them hope and a resolution to make a difference in their country. Until our leaders are committed to servant leadership based on God's word, the economic situation of the poor in Nicaragua will not improve.

CURRICULUM

Provides an English language education on a North American liberal arts framework, preparing students to enter higher learning institutions in the United States and Nicaragua, in compliance with the requirements for our U.S. accreditation. The following textbooks are used: BJU Press (Social Studies), Pearson Reading Street (Language Arts), Pearson (Science, Mathematics), CSI (Bible).
